Gentlemen:

Our New Mexico State V-11, located in Unit K, Section 10, T-21-S, R-37-E, was recompleted as a Blinebry Gas Pool - Tubb Gas Pool dual on Decemb r 2, 1958. Gravity of fluid produced from the Tubb zone was 43.0° AFT, and in accordance with Rule 16 of Commission Order R-586 the Tubb completion was classified as an oil well. Since being placed or production as an oil well January 5, 1959, the Tubb zone has produced fluid with a gravity ranging from 45.6° to 47.6° and averaging 46.6° AFT. It is, therefore, requested that the Tubb completion in New Mexico State V-11 be reclassified as a gas well in the Tubb Gas Pool effective January 23, 1959. Application for a non-standard Tubb Gas Pool proration unit has been made. A revised Form C-110, Certificate Of Compliance And Authorization To Transport Oil And Natural Gas, showing a change in the authorized transporter of gas is enclosed.
