FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The subject well was recently plugged back and recompleted in the Connell. This workover was unsuccessful and well was shut in.

We now propose to pull 2 1/2" tbg.; run and set a B.P. at 7500', dump 2 sx. on top w/a bailer; perforate the Abo 7110-7140', 7010-7045', 6960-6985' w/2 JSPF; run 2 1/2" tbg. w/straddle Pkrs. set lower Pkr. at 7085', middle Pkr. at 7000' and upper Pkr. above 6960'; acidize w/three 5,000 gal. stages of 7.5% LSTNE acid w/buffering additive; drop ball between each stage; pull 2 1/2" tbg. w/Pkrs. and run 2 1/2" tbg.; swab, test and place on production.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of this work.
