Responsive to your letter of August 23, 1989, requesting Form C-103 documentation for the suspected conversion of the subject well from a producer to an injector, please be advised that injection operations have never commenced and the well remains shut-in. No change relative to the NMOCD-approved wellbore utilization scheme (see attached "First Supplement-1988" dated April 28, 1988) has occurred; therefore, NEDU 218 will be recompleted as a Blinbry gas producer in the near future.

We note that recent Form C-115 filings erroneously designate NEDU 218 as an injector; however, injection volumes do not appear on the reports (see attached). As we must infer that the injector status code is the source of the problem, SWEPI will take immediate steps to ensure accurate well status designations in future Operator Monthly Reports.
