STATEMENT

Comes now CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation, hereinafter called "Applicant" and respectfully requests the Oil Commission of the State of New Mexico to issue an order authorizing Applicant to fully complete its W. C. Hawk B-3 No. 3 well, located 1,980 feet from the South and 1,980 feet from the East line of Section 3 T. 21S. R. 37E, Block 15, Lot 15, Hawk B-3 No. 3, in the Drinkard and Blinebry Gas Fields, and to support thereof which show the following:

The proposed gas well contains 160 feet of gas sand and is situated in the northern quarter section.

The test completion of said well is in the Drinkard Formation and the Blinebry Formation for a distance of 100 feet from the surface and the protection of correlation is required.

Completion of the producing intervals will be made by cementing down installation and said well will be equipped so there can be no possibility of well fluid in producing the gas through the annulus between the tubing and casing, and the oil through the tubing. Said well will be equipped in such a manner that reservoir pressure may be determined separately for each of the two gasified pools and the well head equipped with a separator with all necessary connections to permit separate measurement of gas, oil, and gas produced, and also separate production of gas, oil, and gas produced by the formation.

Attached to this application is a plot showing the location of said well and surrounding wells and leasehold and the acreage to be included in the proposed gas well outlined in red on said plot. During the completion of said well at present and after the gas and oil are produced.

All offset operators have been duly notified by copy of this application.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico enter its order authorizing Applicant to dually complete said well in accordance with the foregoing application and rules and regulations of the Commission.

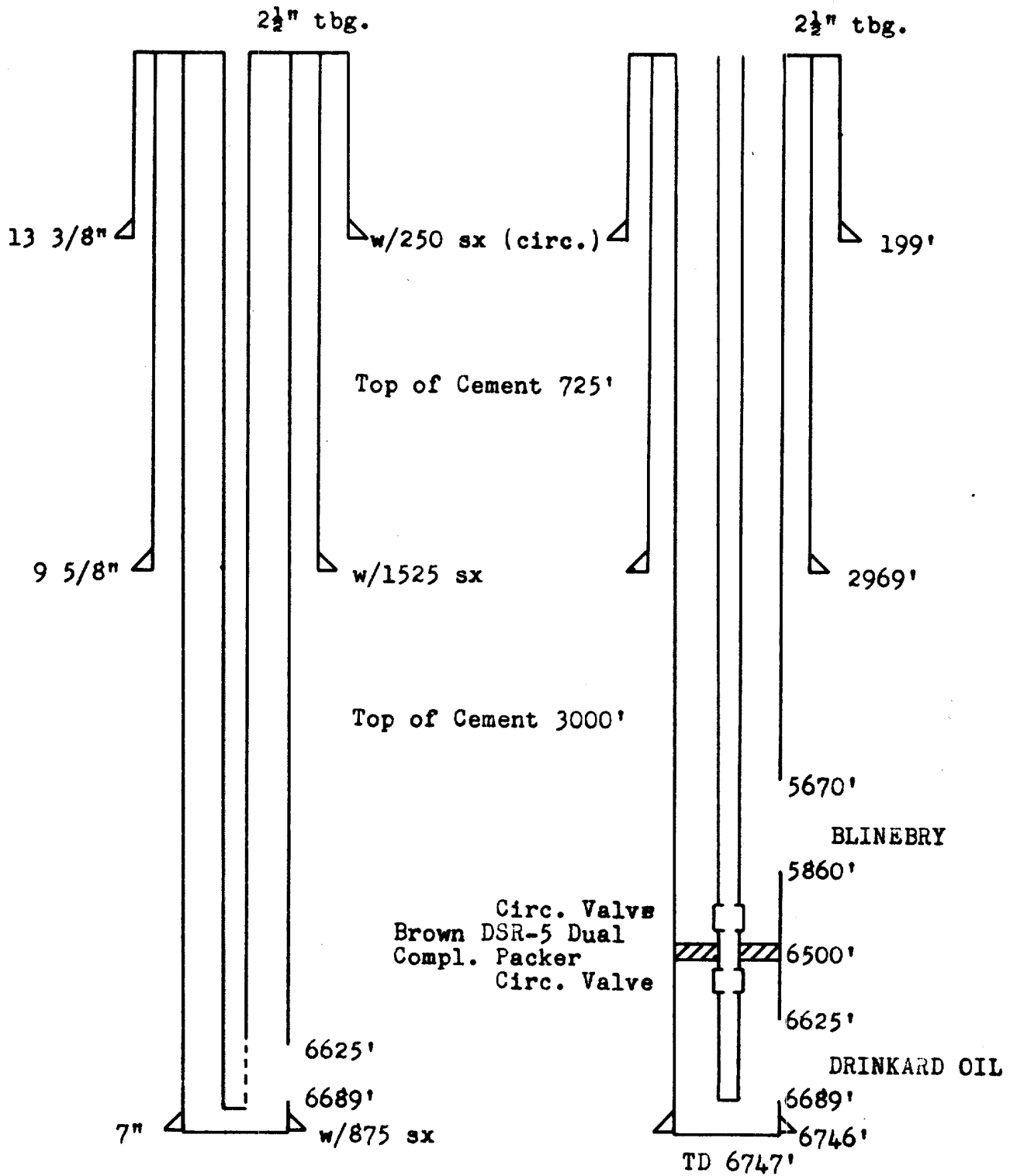

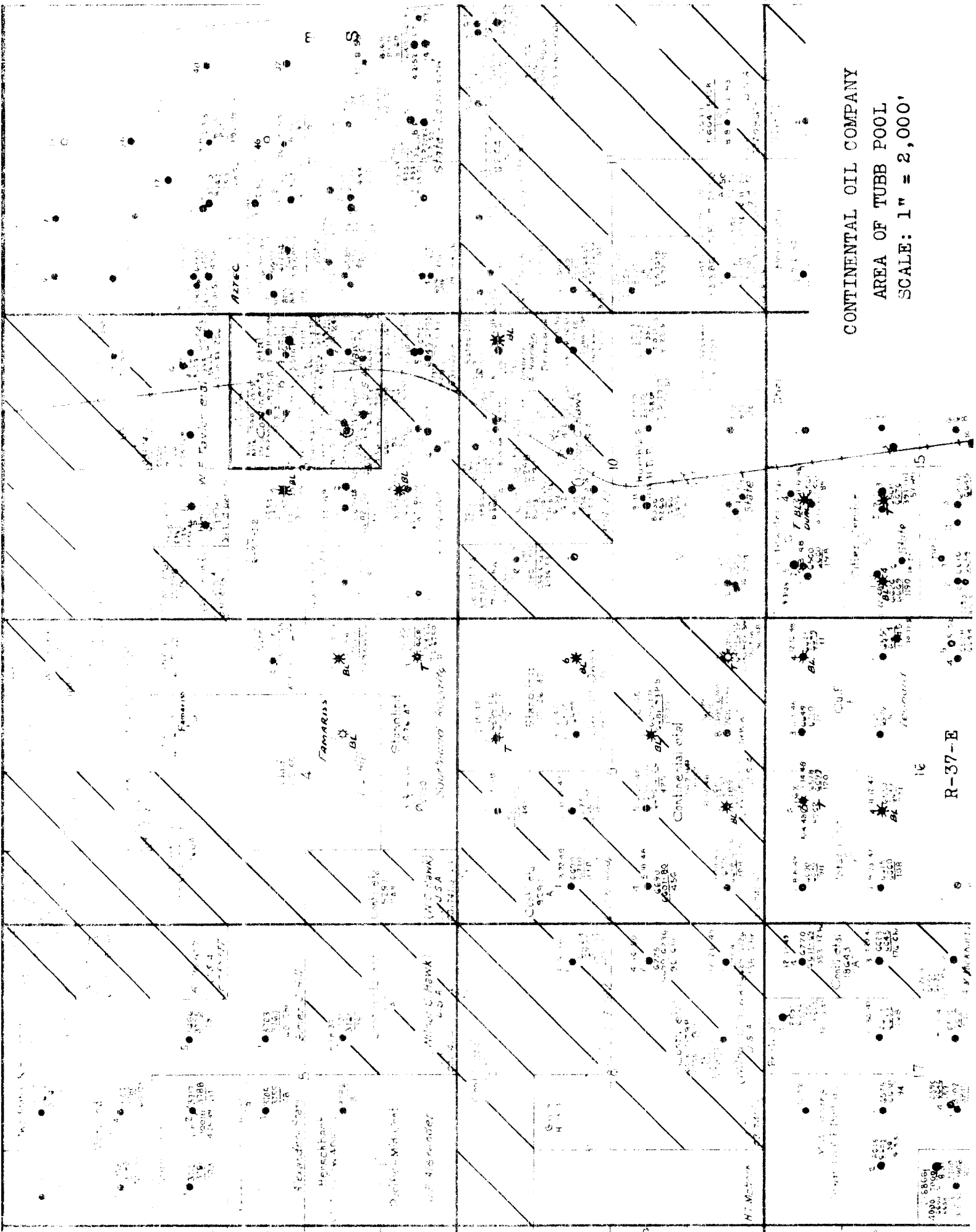
PRESENT CONDITION
