DETAILS OF WORK

The subject well was shut-in during June, 1961, after testing no oil.

We propose to do the following work: Rig up DD unit, load hole, install BOP, pull tubing, run CIBP on wire line and set at 7800' w/1 sx, perf Abo formation w/2 JSPF from 6890-6905', 6955-88', 7045-80', 7190-7205' and 7255-75', treat perfs in three stages w/30,000 gals 15% NE acid containing a buffering agent using three straddle packers located at 6875', 7010' and 7140' on 2 1/2" tubing, pull tubing and packers, re-run 2 1/2" tubing, swab off and test and place on production

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
