DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well is presently shut-in, incapable of commercial production. It is proposed to plugback and recomplete this well in the Wantz Abo Pool in the following manner:

- (a) Set B.P. at 7800' & cap w/2 ex. cement.
- (b) Perf Abo from 7195-7240' & 7270-7325' w/2 JSPF.
- (c) Trt Abo intervals w/15,000 gal of 15% NE acid, containing buffering agent, using 2 straddle packers.
- (d-1) If non-commercial, set B.P. @ 7160' & perf Upper Abo.
- (d-2) If not top allow, perf Upper Abo from 6950-90', 7020-70' and 7110-30' w/2 JSPF.
- (e) Trt Upper Abo intervals w/15,000 gal of 15% NE acid containing buffering agent, using 3 straddle packers.

Subsequent report will be filed upon completion of above work.
I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
