DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a total depth of approximately 6,020' with rotary tools in an attempt to obtain commercial production in the Hlinobry. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing patterns: 250' of 20 3/4" casing to be cemented with approximately 250 sacks, cement to be circulated; 7 5/8" casing to be set at approximately 3050' and cemented with 1,255 sacks cement or sufficient cement to protect the salt section as determined by survey; 5 1/2" casing to be set at total depth and cemented with 415 sacks cement or as determined by survey, and to be perforated opposite the pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
