FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Ran 8 5/8-inch casing and cemented at 2916 feet with 1800 sacks cement. Plug down at 9:15 a.m. 10-3-49. Cement failed to circulate. After 12 hours W.O.C. ran temperature survey. Annular top of cement indicated at 415 feet. Ran 1-inch pipe in annulus to 415 feet. Cemented through 1-inch pipe to surface with 200 sacks. Circulated estimated 2 sacks. Job complete at 2:00 A.M. 10-4-49. After W.O.C., will test casing.
