DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Jet perforated 5 1/2-inch casing 6628 to 6634 feet with 4 shots per foot. Set packer at 6565 feet. Displaced mud with oil. Swabbed 52 barrels load oil. Loaded hole with 143 barrels oil. Treated casing perforations with 130 gallons 20% LST acid. Flowed 17.22 barrels oil and acid water in 1/2 hour. Flowed 18.13 barrels oil in 12 hours thru 12/64-inch choke.
