**Gentlemen:**

**Shell Oil Company requests that New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Amendment to Administrative Order DC-293, dated March 11, 1963, be canceled. This Amendment authorized the dual completion of our Taylor Glenn Well No. 1 in the Drinkard and Blinsbry Oil Pools.**

**Taylor Glenn No. 1 was previously dualled in the Drinkard Oil and Blinsbry Gas Pools. Our attempt to convert Blinsbry Gas to Blinsbry Oil was unsuccessful; therefore, we wish to continue producing the well from the Drinkard Oil and Blinsbry Gas Pools as authorized by the original Administrative Order DC-293.**

**The mechanical installation now in the well is very similar to the one previously authorized. A schematic drawing is attached.**
