Gentlemen:

Shell Taylor-Glenn No. 1 was completed March 1, 1948 as a Drinkard oil producer. The well was recently dually completed as a Drinkard (oil)-Blinebry (gas) producer and approved by Commission Order No. DC-293. By our letter dated September 18, 1956, we requested a hearing be called to consider our application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit to be assigned to Taylor-Glenn No. 1 in the Blinebry gas zone. By present Commission designation, all of the proposed dedicated acreage lies within the defined horizontal limits of the Terry Blinebry Pool. Until such time as our application for a non-standard gas proration unit can be acted upon by the Commission, we request your permission to produce the Blinebry zone on a limiting ratio times unit top allowable basis in effect in the Terry Blinebry Pool. In addition, assuming the allowable will be effective as of September 1, 1956, we wish to request a condensate allowable of 300 barrels for the month based on a daily gas production of 312 MCF/D.
