Gentlemen:

Our J. H. Nolan No. 2, located 660 feet from south and 1980 feet from west lines, Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, was dual completed in the Drinkard for oil and the Tubb for gas on June 5, 1955. A 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit, the S/2 and the NE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, is assigned to the Tubb in this well.

On January 9, 1957, a test was taken on this well, and a gravity of 44° API was reported, with a GOR of 26,200. Although this GOR is sufficient to maintain the well's classification as a gas well, the wellhead flowing pressure is very low and is insufficient to produce into a high pressure gas line.

Remedial work was performed in the Drinkard zone during which the zone was blanked off. Holes were shot in the tubing above the packer and the Tubb opened to production through the tubing.

It is requested that this well be reclassified as a Tubb oil well and NSP No. 198 be cancelled. It is also requested that the allowable for the Drinkard zone be cancelled as this zone is temporarily abandoned.

Application for NFO is being made to your Santa Fe office for venting gas from the Tubb zone in this well.
