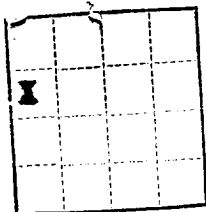

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools at the above location to an approximate TD of 6,050'. Casing will be cemented in accordance with USGS standards and other special requirements will be complied with.

The following casing pattern is planned: 10-3/4" OD casing set at 250' with 250 sacks cement, cement to be circulated to surface; 7-5/8" OD casing to be set at 3,150' with 1,200 sacks cement; 5-1/2" OD casing to be set at 6,050' with 430 sacks cement. Depths and number of sacks of cement are approximate. Exact amount of cement will be determined by caliper survey.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

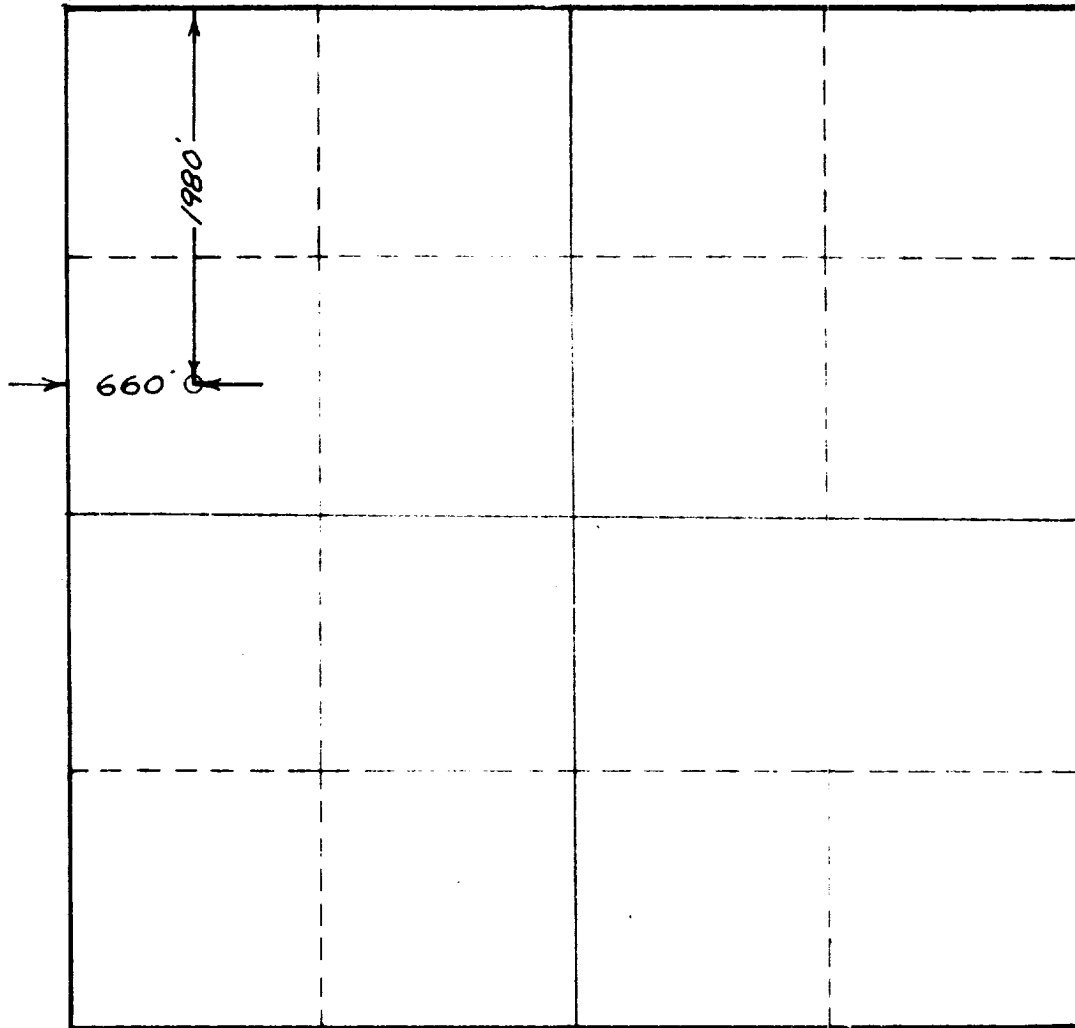
