### DETAILS OF WORK

This well was completed 10-28-52 at a TD of 8149', PB 8145'. Csg. 14" at 8145', Elev. 3400' ST, OF 12'. Pay is Baker and Connell 7770-8096'. Perfs. - Baker 7770-7825', 7836-72', 7908-43', and Connell 8049-96'. Well is presently producing at the rate of 28 BOP and 4 BOPD.

To insure maximum reservoir recovery it is proposed that the above intervals be treated w/10,000 lbs. crude, 15,000 lbs. sand, and 750 lbs. Adonite in five equal stages after the well is cleaned out to PBD.

Subsequent report, stating results obtained, will be submitted upon approval and completion of this work.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
