Permission is requested to dually complete above well in the Blinbry for oil, and the Tubb for gas. Completion method: set cement retainer at 7020' and aqueous off perforations 7063-7125' with 50 sacks. Perforate Tubb from 6050-6300' w/2 jets per ft, treat with acid and sandfrac thru perforations. Perforate Blinbry 5654-5840' with 4 jets per ft, treat with acid and sandfrac thru perforations. Run dual equipment.

A subsequent report will be submitted upon completion of work.
