

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran G.R.-B.N. log; hole caving, could only get to 6919'. Went back in w/drill-stem to clean hole. Ran casing in as far as it would go; set at approx. 7000'; hung 5-1/2" casing in 8-5/8" casing w/ Brown Liner-Hanger and cemented w/700 sax. Let cement set over 72 hours, tested and drilled out. Drilled 4-3/4" hole from under 5-1/2" casing to T.D. of 7145'. Lay down D.P. preparatory to move rotary off to complete.
