DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Treated open hole 6852 to 7342 feet with 15,000 gallons (4,000 - 20% and 11,000 - 15%) LST acid. Packer set in casing at 6689 feet. Total oil and acid load 767 barrels. Recovered load and produced well to determine stabilized capacity. On April 7, 1953, well produced 65 barrels of clean oil on gas lift in 24 hours. Gas injected - 153.6 MCF; total gas produced - 317.2 MCF; net formation gas - 163.6 MCF; net GOR 2517. Well capacity prior to acid treatment: 45 barrels oil per day with GOR 1865.
