DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After reaching total depth 7525 feet in granite, plugged back open hole from 7493 feet to 7342 feet with 75 sacks neat cement. Reversed out estimated 25 sacks. Then ran 210 joints (6842 feet) of 15.5 lb, J-55, SS, new National casing and cemented at 6852 feet with 600 sacks neat cement. Plug down 11:30 AM, December 19, 1952. WOC 48 hours. Tested casing with 1425 psi for 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled plug from casing and washed to bottom. Checked bottom cement plug at 7342 feet.
