At total depth 254 feet: Ran 11 joints (237 feet) 13 3/8" OD, 48 lb., SS, H-40, new, ST&C National Casing with Texas Pattern shoe and cemented at 249 feet with 200 sacks common cement. Plug down 12:30 A.M., November 11, 1952. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 500 psi before drilling plug. No pressure loss. Tests O.K.
