DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 96 joints 2986' of 28 & 32# J-55 & H-40 8-5/8" OD 8 RT SS casing. Set and cemented at 2999' w/2025 sacks cement, 1925 sacks 4% gel and 100 sacks Neat Longhorn regular on bottom. Plug at 2964'. Maximum pressure 1050#. Circulated approximately 24 sacks cement.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 8-5/8" casing w/1000# pressure for 30 min. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 2964' to 2999', tested cement below casing shoe w/400# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
