Shell Oil Company hereby makes application for Administrative Approval to dually complete our Smith Well No. 2 in the Terry Blinebry and Drinkard Oil Pools. As shown on the attached lease plat, Smith No. 2 is located in Unit B, Section 14, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

As illustrated on the attached schematic diagram, the two pay zones will be separated by a permanent production packer, and will flow through separate tubing strings.
