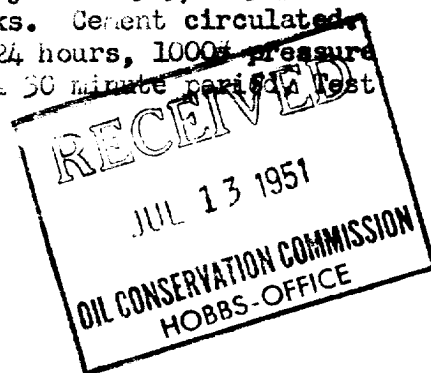

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 315' red bed. Ran 7½ jts of 13-3/8" 36# and 48# casing, 300.30' set at 314.80' and cemented with 325 sacks. Cement circulated. Plug down at 2:05 P.M. 7-10-51. The cement was allowed to set 24 hours, 1000# pressure applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure during a 30 minute period. Test was made prior to and after drilling plug.
