

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 2835' lime. Ran 73-1/2 jts of 8-5/8" 32 and 24# 8 R thd. casing, 2818.40' set at 2835' and cemented with 500 sacks of cement. Plug down 2:38 PM 9-4-51. The cement was allowed to set 48 hours, 1000# pressure applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure during a 30 minute period. Test was made prior to and after drilling plug. Drilling was then resumed.
