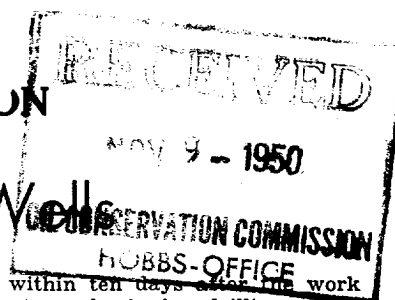

Cement came up to 275' of surface. Drilled cement plug and tested with 1000# pressure for 30 minutes. Test oke. Now drilling ahead.




