Gentlemen:

Attached hereto are two Forms C-102 (Revised 1-1-65) indicating 120 acres dedicated to Marathon Oil Company's L. G. Warlick "C" Wells No. 2 and 9 in the Blinebry Gas Pool. Also attached is a Form C-103 on Marathon's L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 9, indicating re-dedication of its acreage to this 120-acre unit.

The L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 9 was reclassified from the Blinebry Oil to the Blinebry Gas Pool effective July 1, 1966. Therefore, in compliance with Order R-1670, Rule 29 (Special Rules and Regulations, Blinebry Gas Pool), Marathon is filing an application (this date) for administrative approval for a non-standard 120-acre gas proration unit consisting of the W/2 of the SE/4 and the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 15, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This 120-acre unit will include the acreage presently assigned the L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 2, being an 80-acre non-standard Blinebry Gas proration unit consisting of the W/2 of the SE/4 of Section 15, T-21-S, R-37-E (approved by Administrative Order No. NSP-524A), and the 40 acres assigned the No. 9 well in the Blinebry Oil Pool consisting of the SE/4 of the SE/4 of Section 15, T-21-S, R-37-E, providing administrative approval is granted.
