Re: L.G. Warlick C #10-J Sec. 15, T21S, R37E Blinebry Pool Well Producing Without An Allowable

Gentlemen:

The Blinebry oil allowable was cancelled effective January 1, 1985, due to your gas/oil ratio test cuasing the well to be reclassified from oil to gas.

By letter dated October 4, 1984, you were requested to advise us when you had complied with the provisions of Order No. R-1670-N governing gas wells in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool in order that a gas allowable could be signed. We have no record stating that the gas from this well is being separately metered, nor do we have a plat designating the acreage to be dedicated to this well. If you plan to dedicate just 40-acres to this well, you will need approval of a non-standard proration unit. I notice that your 1985 gas/oil ratio test indicates the well should still be classified as a gas well.

You are hereby requested to supply the above as soon as possible in order that a gas allowable may be assigned to this well.
