Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Tidewater's application for dual completion of its State "S" Well No. 3. This well was originally completed in the Ellenburger formation in 1950, and produced from this zone until 1955. The Ellenburger was then plugged back, and the well was completed in the Drinkard zone in 1955. The well is currently still producing from this Drinkard zone with an allowable of one barrel of oil per day.

We propose to plug back the present Drinkard perforations and recomplete in a higher Drinkard pay; furthermore, we propose to dual the well by re-completing in the Blinberry Oil Zone. We expect both zones to flow initially. The zones will be produced through parallel strings of 2 1/16" tubing.

In accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 112-A, we respectfully request permission for dual completion of State "S" Well No. 3 outlined above.
