## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6651' Drilled out depth, pumped in 30 barrels oil, took off Xmas tree and pulled out 2000' of Tubing and filled hole with mud, finished pulling tubing and gun perforated from 6600' to 6623' with 92 holes, Ran Tubing back to 6647' with 1-3' perforated nipple on bottom bull plugged, displaced mud with 150 barrels oil, and swabbed from 6:30AM to 1PM into tanks 75.46 barrels oil and started flowing at 1:30PM and until 7AM on 1" Positive choke made 84.12 barrels oil, CP O TP 250#, Gas Volume 111520, Gas-Oil-Ratio 961. Total off fluid for 24 hours 159.58 barrels of oil.
