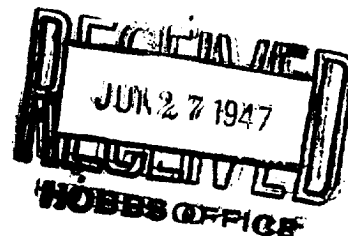

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6654' Total Depth Lime, Ran Temperature Survey and found top of cement at 2850' 98% of calculated fill, Nippled up and went in hole with Tubing and found top of cement at 6532' and tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK, drilled out cement to 6651' and tested Casing with 1000# for 30 minutes and was OK. Gun perforated with Lane Wells 6623 to 6648' with 100 shots, Ran 211 Jts of 2" EUE 4.7#, J-55, R-2, SS Tubing and set at 6647' with 1-3' Perforated nipple on bottom bull plugged and 3-6' Subs on top, displaced mud with 150 barrels oil and ran 20 barrels of water ahead of oil.
