3542' Total Depth, Anhydrite and Lime, made trip and could not get back in hole, found pipe parted at 171' and 1099', Pulled out 171' of Casing and put die nipple and screwed pipe together and milled out casing at 1099' and cemented with 350 sacks El Toro Common and 350 Sacks El Toro Common 3% Howcogel and 100 Sacks Incor and when plug was pumped down 250' cement circulated and closed gate on Braden Head and squeezed with 235 sacks into formation with 600# and plug pumped to 960' at 1:30PM May 27, 1947.
