DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6582' Plugged Back Depth. Acidized with 1000 gallons of Western 15% Low Tension Acid and formation broke at 1450' casing, 1400' tubing. Used flush of 26.4 bbl.s oil. Well kicked off without being swabbed at 4:00PM, 9-22-47 and in one hour flowed estimated 55 bbls. fluid to pits. Turned into tanks on 1/4" positive choke at 5:00PM. In 13 hours well flowed 144.95 barrels oil, 1/10%BS, 3-5% water, gravity 39.4 corrected, gas 193,000 cu. ft. per day, Gas-Oil-Ratio 722. In next 24 hour test well flowed 195.96 barrels oil, 2/10%BS, no water, gravity 37.8 corrected, gas 156,000 cu. ft. per day, Gas-Oil-Ratio 796. Well completed.
