DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6641' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 500 gallons of Western Mud Acid from 2:00AM to 3:10AM. Maximum tubing pressure 1250#. Well kicked off without being swabbed at 3:15AM and flowed estimated 70 barrels of oil and acid water into pits. Turned into tanks on 1/4" positive choke at 5:30AM. In 24 hours well flowed 168.93 barrels of oil, 0% B&W, gravity 39.4 corrected. Gas volume, 511,000 cu.ft. per day. Gas-Oil-Ratio 3024. Next 7 hour test: 15.87 barrels of oil, no B&W, gas volume 510,000 cu.ft. per day. Gas-Oil-Ratio 9402.
