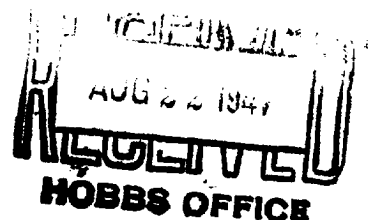

Cemented with 1000 sacks of Atlas Common Cement 3% How-cogel, 500 sacks Atlas Common Cement and 50 sacks Incor Cement and plug pumped to 2749' at 7:30AM, August 20, 1947. Final pressure 900#. Cement did not circulate

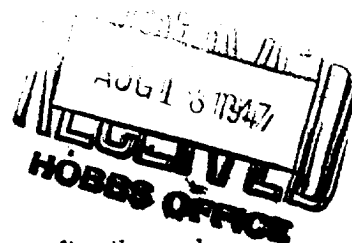
