On October 27, 1948, ran 227 jts new 7" OD 8 Rd Thd, 23#, SS csg w/6 Weatherford csg centralizers spaced @ 6256', 6319', 6411', 6503', 6594', and 6643', and 28 Weatherford reversible scratchers from 6286' to 6642' (7 on bottom jt and 3 on each jt above). Casing detail from bottom up: 24 jts (1092') of A. O. Smith HY R-3 csg, 32 jts (1349') of J-55 R-3 csg, 171 jts (4196') of J-55 R-2 Csg. Total tallies 6637', H-12', set @ 6649'. Cemented by Halliburton w/575 sacks 2% and 125 sacks neat bulk cement. Plug @ 6600'. Job started @ 10 a.m. and completed @ 10:45 p.m.

Propose to drill plug and test shut-off @ 10:45 p.m., October 29, 1948.

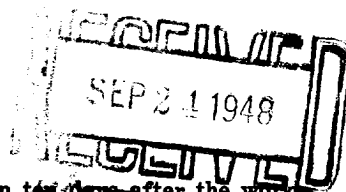
