## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On September 11th, at 6:00 PM 54 hours will have elapsed since setting 6660 feet of 7" 20# and 23# new casing in subject well and cemented with 775 sacks to be used for oil string. At this time casing shut-off will be tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# will be built up and held for thirty minutes, and if casing tests OK, the cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held thirty minutes. If this test, too, is OK, completion operations will be resumed.
