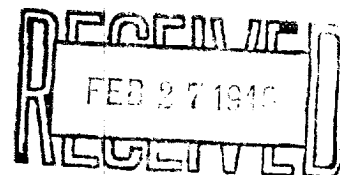

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 13, 1948, at 4:00 P.M., 30 hours had elapsed since running 312' of 13-3/8", 36# new casing in subject well and cementing with 300 sacks, to be used as surface string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes, and this test being OK, cement plug was drilled, and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test too being OK drilling operations were resumed. Stanolind Oil & Gas Co. Head Rslt.

On February 20, 1948 at 11:00 PM, 30 hours had elapsed since running 1385 feet of 9-5/8" 32.3# casing in subject well and cementing with 600 sacks, to be used as intermediate string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held 30 minutes, and this test being OK, cement plug was drilled, and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too being OK, drilling operations were resumed.
