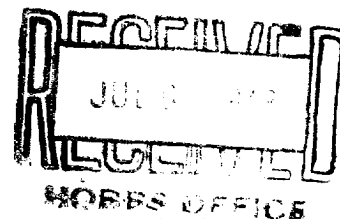

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On July 2, 1948, at 3:40 A.M., 30 hours will have elapsed since running 6694' of 7" casing in subject well and cementing with 1000 sacks to be used as oil string. At this time casing shut off will be tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000 # will be built up and held for 30 minutes, and if test is O.K. cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 1000 # again built up and held for 30 minutes. If this test, too, is O.K., drilling operations will be resumed.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On May 18th, 1948, at 8:00 A.M. 30 hours had elapsed since running 2953' of 9-5/8" new casing in subject well and cementing with 1500 sacks to be used as intermediate string. At this time casing shut off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 1000# was built up and held for 30 minutes, and test was O.K. Cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. This test, too, was O.K. Drilling operations were resumed.
