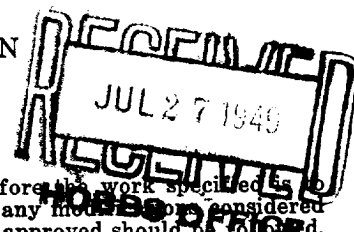

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 9:30 o'clock a.m., July 25, 1949, forty-eight (48) hours will have elapsed since running 6,632' of 5½" casing set at 6629' and cemented with 1300 sacks to be used as oil string. At this time it is planned to test pipe and water shut off by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes, before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 psi occurs on either test, proper remedial measures will be carried out. In event the above tests satisfactorily meet requirements, drilling will be resumed.
