

On June 20, 1949 at 6:15 a.m., 72 hours will have elapsed since running 2898' of 9-5/8" casing set at 2898', and cemented w/1500 sacks. At this time it is planned to test pipe and water shut off by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes, before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 psi occurs on either test, proper remedial measures will be carried out. In the event the above tests satisfactorily meet requirements, drilling will then be resumed.

### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 8:30 o'clock a.m., June 10, 1949, thirty-six (36) hours had elapsed since setting 13-3/8" casing at 335 which was cemented w/300 sacks. At this time pipe and water shut off was tested by applying 500 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes, before and after drilling the cement plug. There was no drop in pressure on either test. Drilling was resumed.
