
Dear Sirs:

On August 7, 1958 I submitted application to dual complete my Lockhart #1 well in NW/4 SW/4, Section 17, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Tubbs Gas and Blinbry Gas pools, and included therewith diagrammatic sketch, location plat and other required information. Permission for this completion was granted on September 9, 1958 in DC-Order 656.

I completed the well as set forth in my application, however the gravity of the liquid produced from the Tubbs Gas pool is such that this well is classified as an oil well.

Mr. Montgomery, of the Oil Conservation Commission, Hobbs, New Mexico, requested that I resubmit this application for dual completion to show this to be Blinbry Gas as the upper zone and oil in the Tubbs Gas pool as the lower zone.
