Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, Neville G. Penrose, Inc. wishes
to state the following information in accordance with Rules
5(a) and (b) of Order R-520, Special Pool Rules, and Rule 112A,
Commission Rules and Regulations:

1. This application is submitted in triplicate.
2. Neville G. Penrose, Inc.'s #1 Percy Hardy, located in the
center of the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 17-21S-37E, was completed
and put on production on January 8, 1950 at a total depth of
6660'. The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this
well on the Neville G. Penrose, Inc. Percy Hardy lease,
covering the SE/4 SW/4 (40 acres), and the Tidewater Oil Com-
pany Percy Hardy lease, covering the S/2 SE/4 (80 acres),
which 120 acres is proposed as a Non-standard Blinebry Gas
Proration Unit. The attached Exhibit "B" shows a diagramatic
sketch of the proposed dual completion.
3. The subject well has 5-1/2 inch casing set at 6599' and is
cemented with 300 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well
producing from the open hole interval 6600-6659' from the
Drinkard formation in the Drinkard Pool.

4. Your applicant proposes to dually complete subject well in the following manner:
 - (a) Perforate the 5-1/2 inch casing within the approximate intervals 5664-5680' and 5710-5722' in the Blinebry formation in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
 - (b) Set production type packer below these perforations at approximately 5775' to separate the two pay zones.
 - (c) Produce the Drinkard Pool oil through the tubing and the Blinebry gas through the tubing-casing annulus.
5. The granting of this application to produce subject well as a dual completion with gas from the Blinebry Gas Pool and oil from the Drinkard Oil Pool, is in the interest of conservation, will protect correlative rights and prevent waste. Your applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission so as to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
6. The manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
7. The proposed Non-standard Gas Proration Unit will meet the requirements of Order R-520 as follows:
 - (a) The Unit will be comprised of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
 - (b) The Unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All of the acreage within the Unit may reasonably be presumed productive of Blinebry gas.
 - (d) The length and width of the Unit does not exceed 5280'.
 - (e) By copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are being notified by registered mail of this proposed dual completion and Non-standard Gas Proration Unit.

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

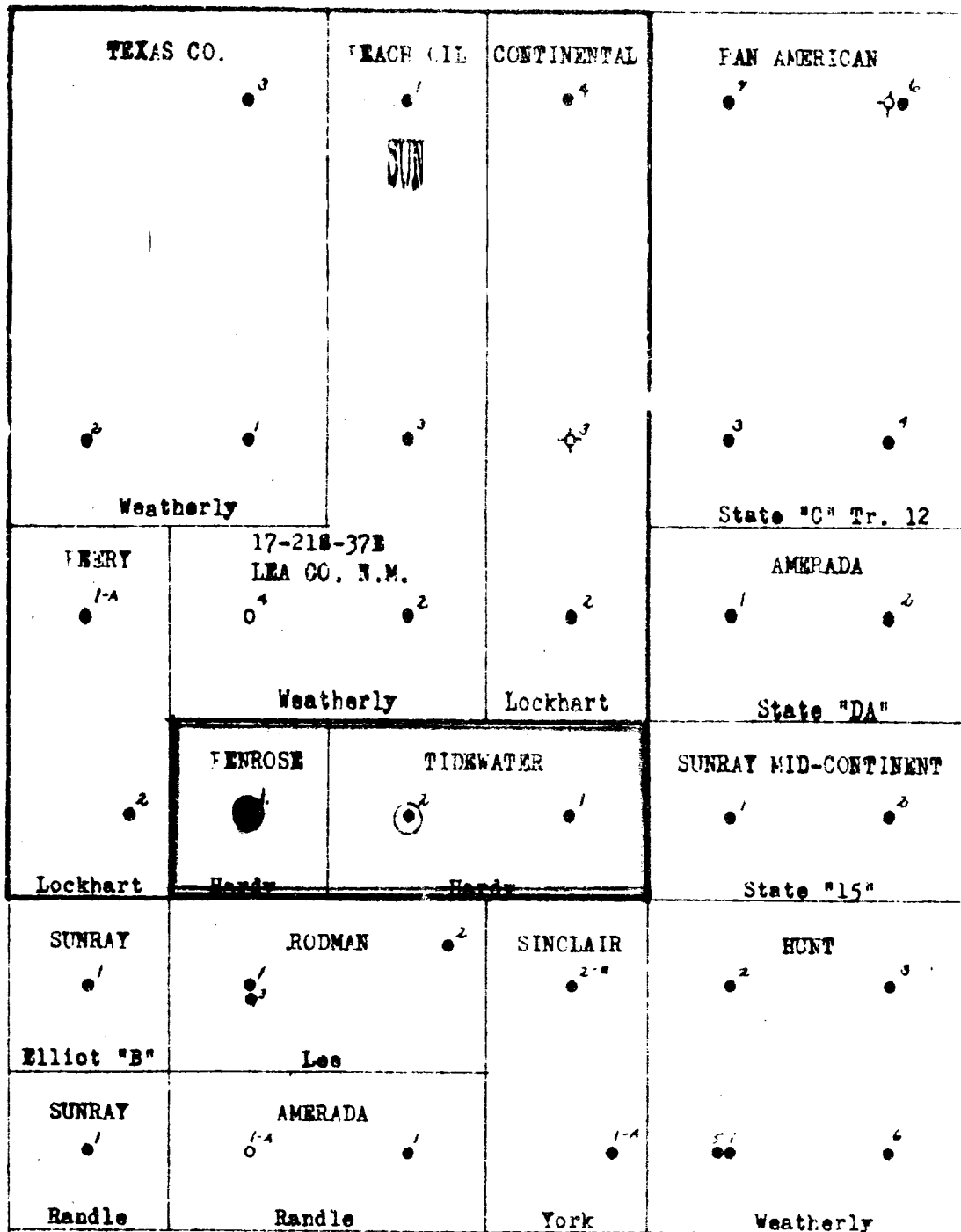
