FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well is producing with a high gas-oil ratio of 43700/1.
Temperature survey indicated base of main gas pay at 3550 feet.
Total depth of well is 3815 feet, with 7"OD casing cemented at 3093.

We propose to kill well, pull tubing, ream hole and then clean out using reverse circulation. Will re-run 2-1/2" tubing with packer and attempt to set packer from 3561 to 3565, below the gas pay, and put well back on production. We plan to use a 5-1/2"OD Lane-Wells formation type anchor packer w/ 3" tubing anchor with perforated nipple.
