The refuge is bounded on the north by the Santa Fe River, on the east by the Santa Fe National Forest, and on the south and west by the Santa Fe River. The refuge is about 10 miles long and 5 miles wide. The refuge is situated on a high plateau, about 7,000 feet above sea level. The climate is semi-arid, with hot summers and cool winters. The vegetation is primarily grassland, with some shrubs and trees. The refuge is home to a variety of wildlife, including deer, antelope, and birds.
