Well loaded with water and acidized with 2000 gallons non-emulsion acid. Casing pressure starting 2100#, tubing pressure 1900#, final pressure casing 1900#, tubing 2000#. Well was then swabbed clean and flowed approximately 4 1/2 barrels oil, no water per hour on 17/64 choke. Well will be re-acidized.
