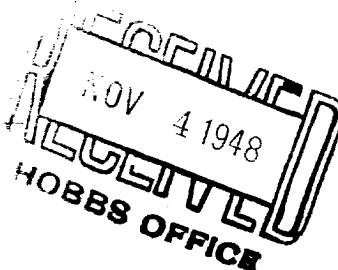

After acidizing w/4000 gals. 15% non-emulsion hydrochloric acid, from 11 a.m. / 4 p.m. flowed 101 bbls. oil, plus 20 bbls. acid water on 1/2" choke, from 4 p.m. / 5 a.m. flowed 85 bbls. oil plus 15 bbls. acid water on 1/4" choke. TP 275#, CP 50#.
10/27/48, 9:30 a.m. / 5 a.m. flowed 136 bbls. oil on 1/4" choke, CP 1075, TP 260;
10/28/48, from 5 a.m. / 5 a.m. flowed 164.22 bbls. oil on 1/4" choke, CP 1125, TP 650#.
