on 1/4" choke, CP 290#, TP 290#; 10/25/48 from 5:30 a.m./5:30 p.m. flowed 91.00 bbls.  
oil on 1/4" choke, TP 210#, CP 900#, corr. gravity 36.7, 4/10 of 1% N2.
