Fill well to pull rods and tubing. Run electric log. Perforate 5 1/2" casing with 2 jet shots per foot from 5668' to 5710' and from 5775' to 5856'. Set retainer NP in 5 1/2" casing at 5900'. Acidize with 2000 gals. regular 15% acid, followed with 30,000 gals. refined oil at 12.1 BPM. Job complete 8:28 P.M. 8/20/59. Recover lead oil, test Elizavira zone. Return well to production after dual work is completed in Tubbs and Elizavira Oil Zones.

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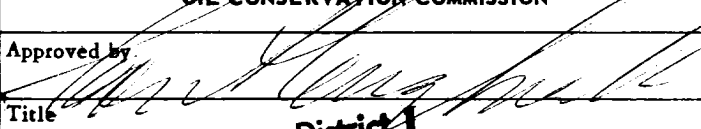
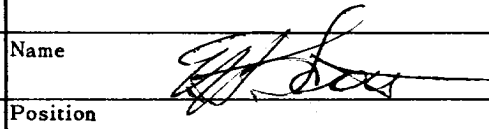
