DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled to 315', redbeds, ran 13-3/8" O.D. casing to 315' and cemented w/ 300 sx., Halliburton process, cement preceded by mud, cement circulating to surface. Let set 24 hours and at approximately 9:00 P.M. August 9, 1950 pressured up to 1000# on casing, let set 1 hr. w/ no decrease in pressure, indicating effective casing shut-off. Drilled plug and pressured up to 1000#, let set 1 hr. w/ no decrease in pressure, indicating effective water shut-off.
