GENTLEMEN:

TODAY A SURVEY WAS MADE TO LOCATE YOUR STATE "CK" WELL NO. 1 AT A POINT 2209 FEET FROM THE WEST LINE AND 330 FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, N.M.F.M., LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

A FLAG WAS SET UP AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 19 AND THE TRANSIT WAS SET UP AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 19. THEN WE CHAINED EASTERLY ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SECTION 19 A DISTANCE OF 2209 FEET SETTING A HUB. THEN WE CHAINED NORTHERLY, PARALLEL TO THE HALF SECTION LINE A DISTANCE OF 330 FEET TO THE LOCATION OF YOUR STATE "CK" WELL NO. 1.

AS A CHECK ON OUR SURVEY WE CHAINED WESTERLY A DISTANCE OF 2209 FEET AND SOUTHERLY A DISTANCE OF 330 FEET CLOSING WITHIN 0.25 FEET OF LATITUDE AND DEPARTURE, WELL WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THIS SURVEY.

I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT THE FOREGOING NOTES WERE TAKEN IN THE FIELD FROM A BONA FIDE SURVEY AND THAT THE SAME ARE TRUE AND CORRECT TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE AND BELIEF.

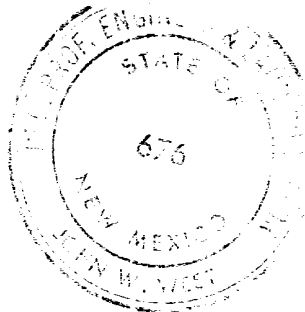
