MARCH 30, 1966 PRESSURE TEST HEAD - O. K. RAN OTIS LIFT LIFT BLOCK IN LONG STRING TO 5309. GOT FICTURE OF PLANTED TUBING.

MARCH 31, 1966 KILL BOTH ZONES WITH FINE WATER FILL RODS AND BOTH TUBING STRINGS. LONG STRING PARTED THREE JOINTS BELOW PARALLEL STRING ANCHOR AT A SPOT WHERE CORROSION WAS SEVERE. RUN TUBING WITH OVERSHOT. SILENCE FROM LOGGING JACKER & PULL OUT TUBING. REPLACE LOWER 13 JOINTS WITH NEW 2-3/8" OD BURE J-55 TUBING WITH PARALLEL STRING ANCHOR AT 5222' G.L. RUN & SET SHORT STRING OF TUBING AND RODS. WORK COMPLETED APRIL 3, 1966. ON APRIL 6 PUMPING LOAD WATER FROM PUMP - LOG; BUT BOTH ZONES STILL DEAD. WILL REWORK LATER & AT AGE TEST IN GENERAL DAYS.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
